

Job Title: Projection and Lighting Design Work Study Student

Job Description:

As a Projection and Lighting Design work study student, you will be responsible for supporting the design, installation, and execution of the projection and lighting elements of an April/May 2024 Work of Art premiere youth theater production titled *Antigone's Last Birthday*. Under the direction of the Projection and Lighting Designers, as well as the Stage Manager, the Projection and Lighting Design Intern will attend production meetings with the director, youth and staff to help determine lighting and projection needs of production. The work study student will assist with workflow, scheduling and execution and installation of projection and lighting design elements, assist with performances, and support the load in and strike of these design elements at the Rosenthal theater facility.

Additional desired skill sets include:

- 1) student is invested in working on projects with a strong equity imperative in architecture
- 2) student is interested in virtual media / virtual space (ideally MArch II)
- 3) student knows either Blender or Maya well and can proficiently model and texture map custom objects.
- 5) student is familiar with entry level animation workflows.
